- 1. A motion was made by Jim Stubbs and seconded by Becky Carroll to form a 2 person committee of Allan Sassin and Keith Barker to work with the City of West Columbia and the District's legal counsel on the Sewer Contract with the City of West Columbia and the vote was unanimously adopted 5-0.
- 2. Jim Stubbs motioned for the committee and seconded by Beck Carroll to hire Ray Sauer to consult with the committee at a rate of \$221.00 per day on the Sewer Contract and the vote passed unanimously 5-0.
